



Routine Maintenance and Care:

1. Regular Cleaning

Sweep: Use a broom or a leaf blower to remove dirt, leaves, and debris from the surface of the pavers.

Wash: Clean the pavers with a mild detergent solution and water. Use a soft-bristle brush to scrub away any stains. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Pressure Washing: For tougher cleaning, use a low pressure washer (maximum 1,600 psi).

2. Stain Removal

Oil and Grease: For oil and grease stains, apply a degreasing agent and scrub with a soft-bristle brush. Rinse well with water.

Organic Stains: For stains caused by organic matter like food, plants, or leaves, use a mixture of water and bleach (1:10 ratio). Apply the solution, let it sit for a few minutes, then scrub and rinse thoroughly.

3. Inspect for Damage

Regularly inspect the pavers for cracks or chips. If you find any, consider replacing the damaged pavers to prevent further issues.

4. Preventive Measures

Seal the Pavers: While porcelain pavers are naturally resistant to staining and moisture, sealing them can provide extra protection. Apply a high-quality sealer every 1-2 years.

Use Furniture Pads: Place pads under furniture legs to prevent scratches and damage to the pavers.

Avoid Harsh Chemicals: Refrain from using harsh chemicals or acidic cleaners, as they can damage the surface of the pavers.

5. Seasonal Care

Winter Care: In colder climates, avoid using metal shovels or sharp tools to remove snow and ice. Instead, use a plastic shovel and consider applying a non-corrosive de-icer.

Spring and Summer Care: During warmer months, clean the pavers more frequently to prevent the buildup of pollen, dust, and other debris.

6. SkyJack Pedestals

Leveling: Periodically check the level of the pavers as settling of the building may cause the pavers to shift. If you notice any unevenness or rocking pavers, adjust the height of the pedestals to maintain a flat, stable surface. You can use our hand tool in order to adjust the pedestals from on top of the pavers without having to remove the pavers. You may also need to add rubber shims to ensure all of the paver corners are flush.

7. Professional Maintenance

Periodic Professional Cleaning: Schedule professional cleaning and maintenance every few years to ensure the longevity and appearance of your pavers. Professional services can provide deep cleaning and resealing if needed.
